Most missionaries go to a people group somewhere in the world, learn those people's language and culture, and tell them about Jesus. That is wonderful! But that is not the only way to be a missionary.

From North America To the World

Have

you ever wanted to do something so bad it burnt inside like your heart was on fire? Did you ever feel a nudge inside telling you what to do, or what not to do?

Didn't it feel right when you obeyed and listened to God?

My name is Paul Muzzin and I am working part-time with World Team Canada in mobilization (helping people become missionaries) and media development. My wife Stephanie and I want to see our culture change through the use of films, documentaries and YouTube videos. "Culture" means how people in a place or country think about and do things.



Stephanie and I believe that we should reach people through their culture, and our North American culture uses media a lot.

It all started for us when I went to college in Media Arts (Film school). I wanted to be famous but God showed me what I could do for the eternal Kingdom of God. I



searched in my heart what was right and how to put my skills in use for the sake of the Gospel. Seven years went by while God showed us that He gives the skills and the resources. In our case the resources were a video camera and all the equipment we needed to start making our own films.

My wife and I moved to a

community just outside of Toronto, Ontario, Canada. God gave me many ways to get more experience doing films and documentaries.

What we do as media missionaries has two sides. First are films about World Team missionaries all over the world so the missionaries' churches in North America can see what they do and, more importantly, what God is doing in the world. Secondly, we want to make independent movies to show people in our culture who don't yet know Jesus Christ, how He is changing lives everywhere.

Both of these jobs are important. When Christians see stories about missionaries' lives, we hope it will make them want to obey God and go out to tell the Gospel to other people groups, too. Then that new missionary could have a wonderful story to tell for a short film. Stephanie and I strongly believe that as Christians watch and hear about how different people are being touched by God's

➡ Can you think of some other ways, besides the ones on page 5, that we can use to tell people the Gospel? If you can, write them down here:


➡ Now read what the great missionary, the Apostle Paul, said in 2 Corinthians 9:22 (on page 6).
